<b>Any skills or qualifications needed for entry to the class</b>	This course is aimed at those with little or no knowledge of belly dance. Previous dance experience would be an advantage but is not essential.	
<b>Materials required for first class</b>	Please bring a packed lunch. The tutor will provide handouts, music and dance props. Please wear clothing that is easy to move in, you may wish to bring a notebook and a bottle of water.	
<b>Course description - Including aims &amp; objectives</b>		
<p>The world of belly dance consists of a huge range of styles of music and dance, each with its own cultural roots. This one-day workshop will look at some of the more popular styles of Egyptian belly dance, including folk and modern styles, you'll learn about their cultural background, costuming, musical characteristics and instruments. You will also be introduced to Arabic drum rhythms and will have the chance to try various dance props.</p> <p>Through-out the day you will learn several short dance combinations which we will put together to create a full Egyptian dance routine.</p>		

<p>This workshop aims to give you an introduction to Middle Eastern dance, to encourage teamwork and to inspire creativity through dance.</p>	
<p><b>How Progress &amp; Success will be recorded:</b>  Each student will be given an individual tracker form at the beginning of the day with tutor set aims and personal goals for the day. You can take the workshop at your own speed and there will be options through-out the day so you can choose to do what suits you and your abilities. "Success" will be measured by your enjoyment of the day.</p>
