Year 11 Mock Examinations



This can include half term, although we appreciate that rest and relaxation needs to be encouraged over the half term break too. Lunchtime and Session 6 revision classes will continue after half term and we encourage students to take advantage of these.

Please encourage your children to take these mock examinations seriously as their performance will help teachers make their final predictions that will be used on their applications to post-16 centres. Courses have clear entry requirements and students are unlikely to be offered places if their predictions do not match these entry requirements.
