Year 11 GCSE Music – October Half Term Booster Session

On Tuesday 27th October (this upcoming half-term holiday), I will be running a booster session for Yr 11 GCSE Music. This session will take place between 9am to 3pm, in LG1. Refreshments and snacks will be provided by the Music department, but please can students bring a packed lunch with them. Students will need to meet myself at front reception at 9am in order to access the school site and will depart from front reception at 3pm. It is incredibly important that students arrive on time, and that they remain in school until 3pm as all students will need to be escorted when on site. Please can appropriate travel arrangements be made for your son or daughter for this day.

This booster session is specifically designed to provide students with a comprehensive overview to the two final Areas of Study that still need to be taught – AofS 3 (Rhythms Of The World) and AofS 4 (Film Music). This booster session, in addition to the curriculum time that your son or daughter has already received, will ensure that they are in the best possible position they can be in for their Yr 11 assessment in Music (taking place week commencing 9th November).

While this booster session is not compulsory, it is strongly advised that all Yr 11 Music students attend if possible. I will be re-teaching both AofS3 and AofS4 in more detail following the November assessments, however, attendance at this booster session will ensure that your son or daughter has the best possible chance of being successful in their Music assessment in November.
