## School Uniform Reminder

As we move into the second term I would like to reinforce our continued expectations of uniform.

The standards and expectations we have and share have not changed in terms of the style of trousers, **length of skirt**, and formal shoes that are required (please see attached guidance). Uniform continues to play an important role in raising the level of professionalism that is expected from all of our students and we appreciate your continued support in this matter. **Incorrect uniform will be challenged from 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2020** and students that do not have the correct uniform will receive **behaviour points**. We ask that you ensure any uniform infringements are corrected over the October half-term break.

We continue follow the COVID guidance and keep our learning spaces well ventilated; this will see a reduction in room temperature which we will try to offset by keeping our heating on. Our recommendation is that layers of clothing may help keep students comfortable as they can be removed when hot and can be applied if cold. The use of the school jumper is a good example of this. I would like to reinforce the message that **the school blazer must be worn** as the default and **not just the college plain black jumper**. Teachers will be encouraged to use their discretion to allow students to wear outdoor coats in lessons if they feel this is necessary. This is not the choice of the student, but a decision made by the member of staff.

## Hands Face Space

Face coverings are to be worn when entering and exiting the college and are to be worn when entering and moving across the site during the day (a small number of students are exempt from wearing face masks). Space and social distancing are also identified as key components in keeping people safe - students must keep within their year group zones and, when they finish their day, they must keep their face coverings on. We would also encourage students to not wait around for friends or congregate in groups that breach the rule of 6 or within 2 meters without a face covering on. Once dismissed, students must make their way home promptly.

If you have any questions or concerns regarding uniform, please contact the relevant senior tutor or House office. We will endeavour to work with you to ensure that all of our students are able to meet our high standards.

Thank you for your continued support in this matter and in helping us maintain a high standard. - Plain black skirt OR plain black full length tailored trouser
- Grey jacket with piping and school logo
- Plain white shirt with collar
- Plain black V neck knitted jumper (optional)
- House tie
- Black shoes

Skirts must be **knee length** in either A-line, Pleated, Box Pleat or Straight styles **with black tights**

Skirts purchased from Price and Buckland will meet the school's style expectations but it is important height is considered to ensure they are knee length



- House PE top
- Plain black PE shorts
- Black PE fleece (optional from P&B)
- Black sports trouser (optional from P&B)

**A warm waterproof jacket is needed during COVID, due to all lessons being outside.**

Families eligible for pupil premium funding may request assistance with the purchase of a jacket (50%). Agreement must be obtained from your Senior Tutor and an order code obtained from the Finance Office (the code will be changed periodically).

There is a stock of ties that may be purchased throughout the year from House Offices (£5).

**Key Points when ordering uniform:**

- Families eligible for pupil premium funding may request assistance with the purchase of the jacket (50%). Agreement must be obtained from your Senior Tutor and an order code obtained from the Finance Office (the code will be changed periodically).

- The only items that must be purchased from our designated supplier are:

<b>House Tie</b>	<b>PE Top</b>
<b>Jacket</b>	<b>Optional PE Items</b>

- There is a stock of ties that may be purchased from Reception for £5.00
- There is a small stock of jackets that students can borrow if they have either forgotten or mislaid their jacket. These can be signed out from Reception and must be returned.
- Should parents wish to check jacket sizing before purchasing a new item, there are various sizes to try at Reception.
- Orders placed by parents can be delivered to school during term time only, they will be sent home with the student



With a view to ensuring our uniform policy is fit for purpose and suits the needs and care of our students, Senior Leadership have reviewed the Winter uniform guidelines and would like to make the following 'Winter only' alterations.

In addition to all season plain black shoes, the Ely College uniform policy allows 'winter only' plain black ankle boots under trousers.

Due to COVID 19 & the need to keep PE outside even in the winter months, it is **imperative that students bring appropriate wet weather clothing with them for their PE lessons.**

We ask that this now includes a warm waterproof jacket (ideally plain blue or black in nature), along with a warm jumper/sweater.
